

## Palm Sunday Common Holy Week






Psalm 22:8-9, 17-18, 19-20, 23-24. R./v. 2a





## **Psalm Tone**



Psalm 22:26-27, 28, 30, 31-32. R/v. 26a

1. I will fulfill my vows before those who fear

- 2. All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to the LORD; *[omit C, D]* all the families of the nations shall bow down before him. *R*/
- 3. To him alone shall <u>bow</u> down all who sleep in the earth; *[omit C, D]* before him shall bend all who go down into the dust. *R/*
